What is the AEC?

The AEC is an initiative supported by the Australian Government and Australian Employers to provide job-specific training and guaranteed jobs for Indigenous Australians who complete the training.

The AEC seeks to improve the life of tens of thousands of Indigenous people in our country by giving you a direct avenue to the tremendous benefits of having a job, of feeling useful to yourself, your family and your country.

How does it work?

As a participant, you will sign up to the AEC and commit to undertake training and then employment with AEC Employers.

Upon meeting the requirements of training and participation, you will be guaranteed a job by a participating employer.

Once in the workplace, you will be closely supported by a mentor in a one on one relationship.

Moving into the workplace can be a challenging experience but it is also very rewarding. Just as you commit to the AEC, we make a commitment to you to provide ongoing support and guidance.
